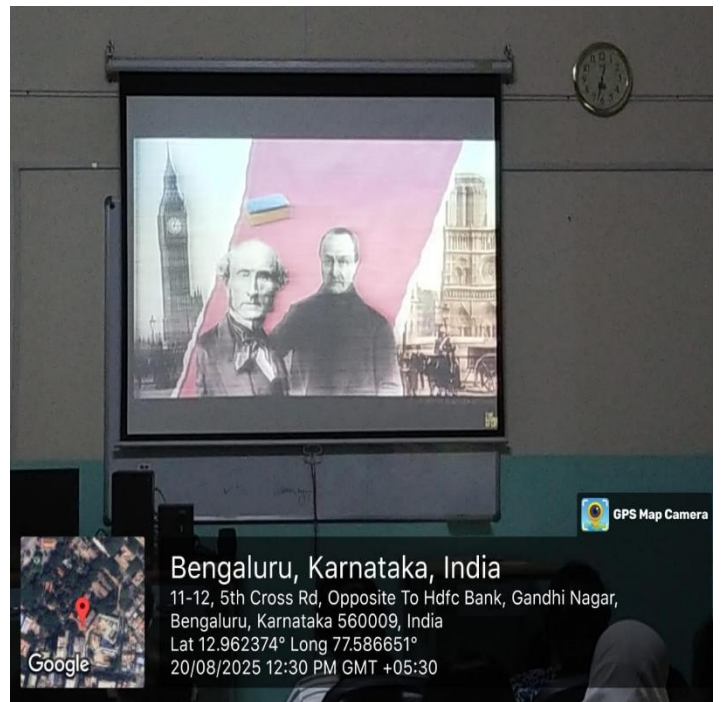
1.Documentary Screening:

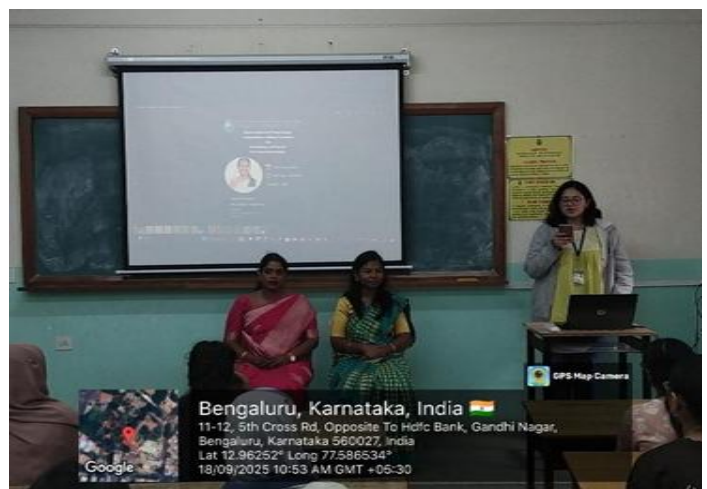

3.Intefor-Collegiate Fest:

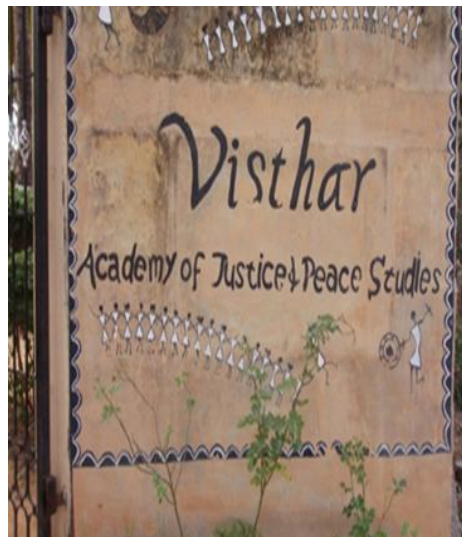
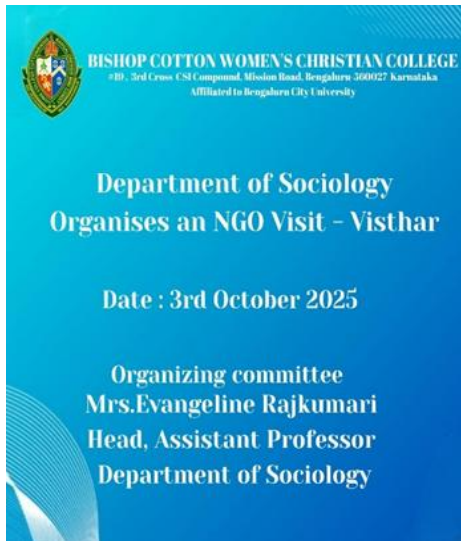

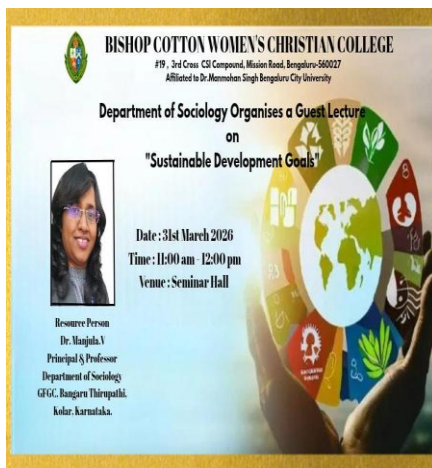
8. Bulletin Board:

The II BA Students of Sociology displayed the bulletin board theme: “Digital Society and Youth” on 19th Feb 2026.



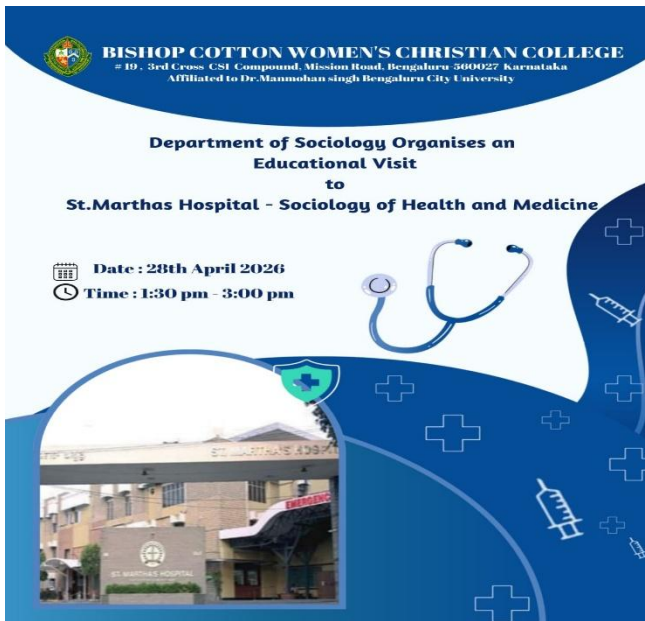
9. Guest Lecture:
