On the 15th of December 2021, students of IIIBCA (29 students) and IIBCA (11 students) accompanied by two faculty members, Mrs.Jayakiruba and Mrs.Ann Kuruvilla, visited Local Public Exhibition organized by the Ministry of Defence. It highlighted the history of Defence Quality Assurance over the last 75 years.

- We were honored to be invited to the DGQA (Directorate General of Quality Assurance) public display, and we are grateful to Maj Gen SD Chowdhary Sir and his team for making it such a memorable event.
- We got an insight into the equipment used by the troops and the working of military tanks. HAL, BEML, and BEL, all of which are based in Bangalore, also exhibited their designs.
- The team provided all information regarding military testing standards and procedures. The Director of the DGCA was also present for a Q&A session.
 Finally, each of us were given a pen with the words "AZADI KA AMRIT MAHOTSAV" inscribed on it, as a memento.
