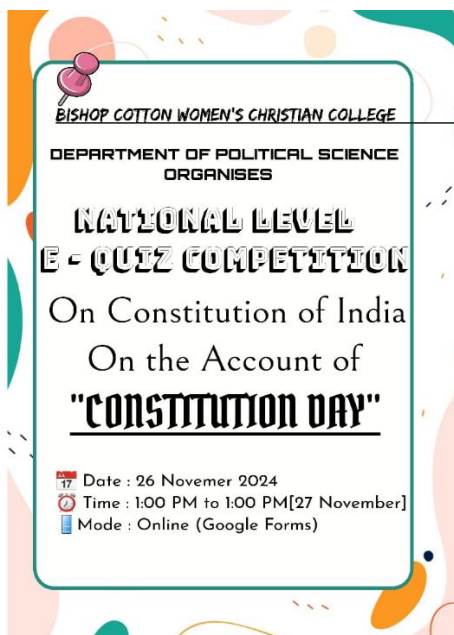
FIELD VISIT

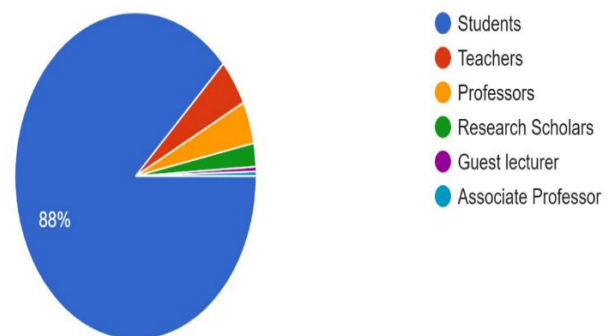


E-QUIZ
