EVENT DETAILS

The 'Anti-ragging' awareness programme was organized by the Student Welfare committee on 14 th of August 2025 for all the second year degree students. The programme was organized with the aim of installing the concept of anti ragging in the hearts of the students..

The students were encouraged to prepare chart works in various forms on the topic of Anti-ragging. The student welfare committee teachers gave away their words on how ragging is a crime, how they would take an action against it and how the students had to handle the issue. The Students council prepared a flash mob with participants from 1st and 2nd year degree students and a skit to portray the effects of ragging and their solutions.





The skit depicted two different victims one who tried to end her life and the other who stood up for herself. The skit explained the solution to be friends, parents and teachers. The flash mob on the other hand portrayed the pain and the agony of the victims.

The students were encouraged to stand up for themselves when they face ragging and also the skit assured that the guilty will not go unpunished since ragging is a crime. The skit ended with a strong note 'Break the silence, stand out, stop ragging before it starts'.

The student welfare committee installed the Anti-ragging committee for the academic year which included teachers and two members from the student council to ensure that students have a strong and unwavering support form the institution.

The programme put up a strong message in the students' minds, 'Stand up for yourself because ragging is not fun but a crime'.
