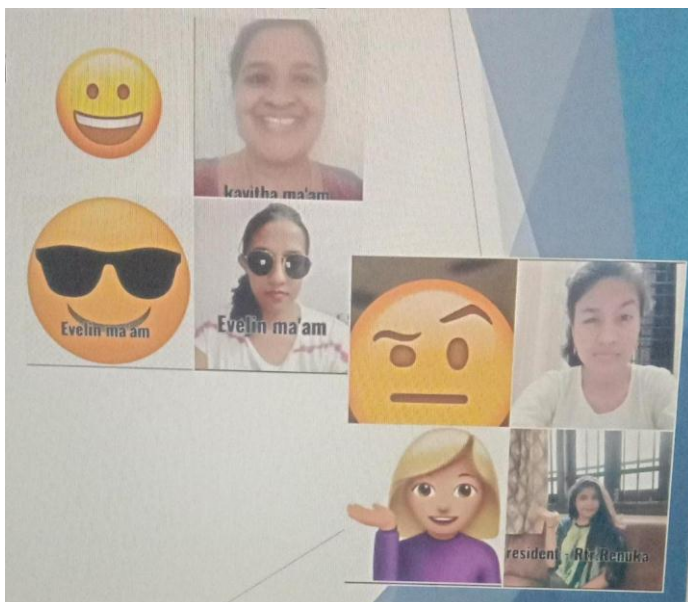
CLUB ACTIVITIES –are organised to bring the club members together especially during this pandemic on online platforms with a variety of fun and learning activities.

INDEPENDENCE DAY

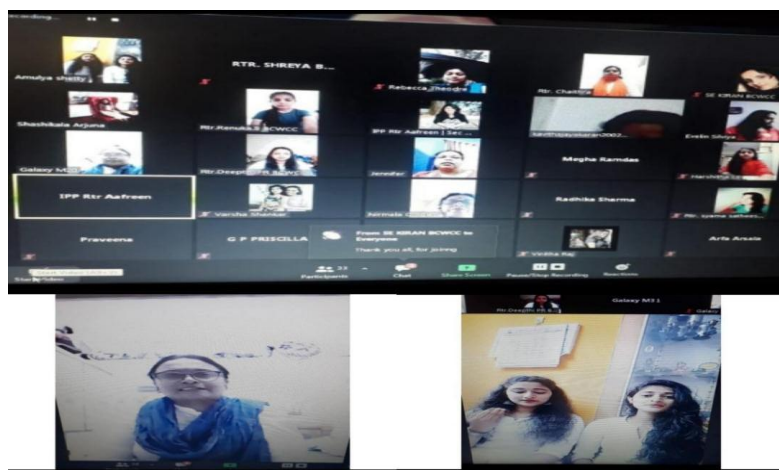

COMMUNITY SERVICES

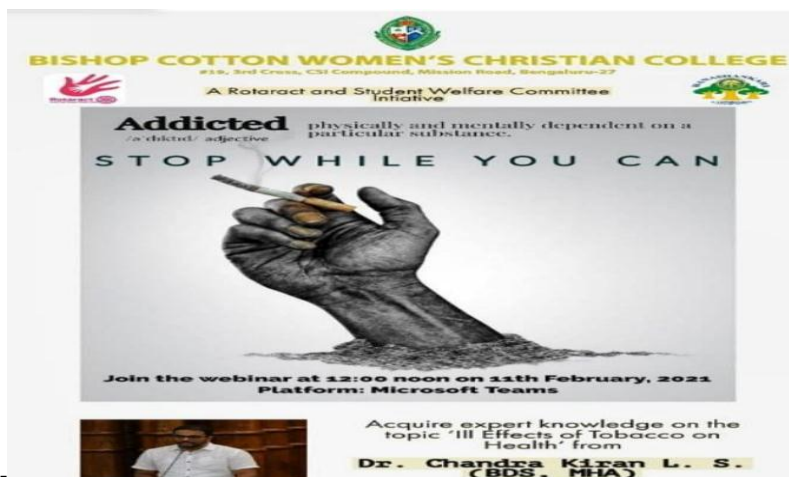
AWARENESS Webinar on ILL EFFECTS OF TOBACCO ON HEALTH

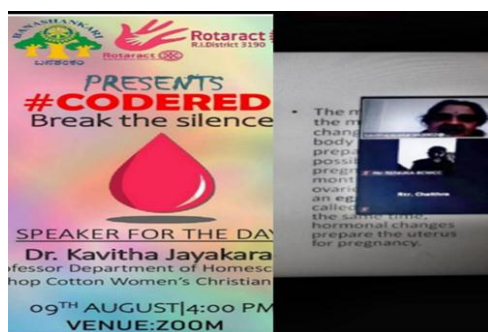


CODE RED – Menstrual Health Awareness Program

kind of green plants and conserve nature



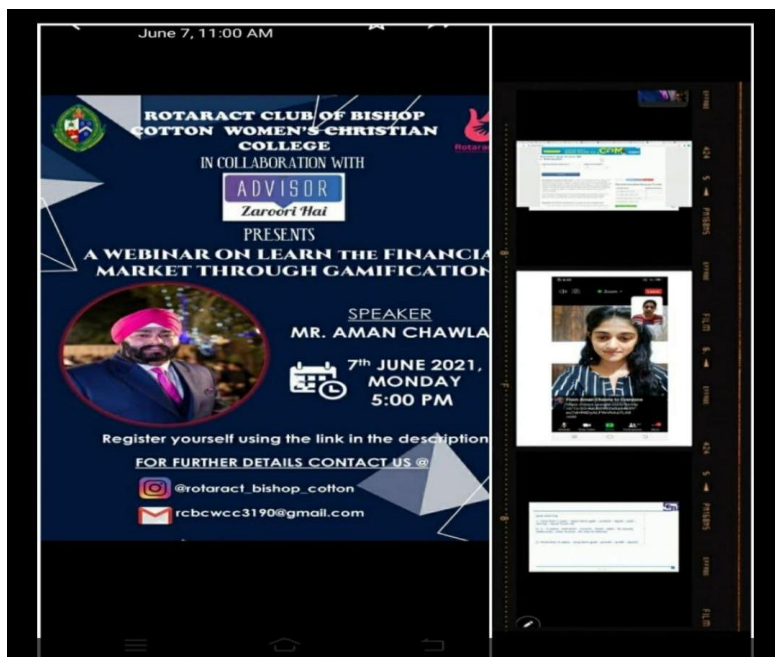
INTERNATIONAL DOG'S DAY
